

NEXT STEPS

In this course you have learned about the Bible and the wonderful future God has promised to those who obey his word.

You have seen that only God can show us a way to escape from sin and death. Only Jesus Christ, the Son of God, can lead us to the kingdom of God. We have to believe in him as our saviour. We have to understand what he did for us in his death.

We must repent and be baptised. We must live new lives with Jesus as our master, waiting for him to return to set up God's kingdom. If we do these things, Jesus will give us eternal life, free from all problems, when he comes.

This Bible message is the most important teaching you can ever have in your life and we want you to learn more about it.

The first thing to do is to talk to God in prayer. Ask him for help to understand his word, the Bible. Ask him for help to seek his Kingdom. Jesus taught us that we should pray like this every day. This is the most important thing you can do.

The next thing to do is to read the Bible. Look at these words.

2 Timothy 3:15-17

'You have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.'

Paul wrote these words to a young man called Timothy. He told him how important the Bible should be in his life. You cannot find out the truth about God in any other book, only in the Bible.

In this course we have told you about the God of the Bible. The most precious thing we can have in life is to belong to God through his son, Jesus Christ.

These words are a prayer that we can all say to the God who loves us and wants us to be with his son in the kingdom of God.

Jude 24

'To him who is able to keep you from falling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy, to the only God our Saviour be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages, now and for evermore! Amen.'

If you do not have a Bible, tell your tutor and ask for help. If you cannot read very well, find a friend who can read the Bible to you and who can help you to learn to read it. You should try to read the Bible every day. It is also a good idea to learn some of the Bible off by heart.
