

A COURSE ON MATTHEW'S GOSPEL

ABOUT THIS COURSE

This course is designed for students who have completed the 40-lesson Bible Postal Course from the Christadelphian Bible Mission. It aims to help you understand more fully the life and work of Jesus Christ by reading and thinking carefully about the Gospel record.

You should already be reading from the Bible daily, perhaps with the help of the Bible Reading Planner or the Bible Companion plan (step 7) which you received as part of the 40-lesson course. Please continue your daily Bible readings as you follow this course on Matthew's Gospel. The more familiar you become with the Bible as a whole, the more you will understand and enjoy the Gospel record.

In this Bible Correspondence Course you should read carefully through each of the chapters in the book of Matthew, and then answer the questions which are set for the chapter. Write your answers on a piece of paper.
